### 1. Baby Quilts – Welcome Little One

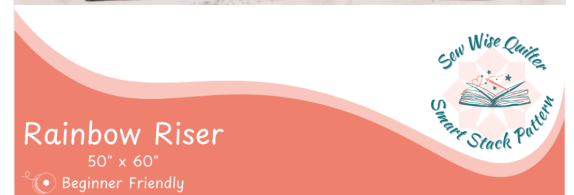
