


T.O.M. - Pineapple

In this month's T.O.M. class, we'll be mastering the Pineapple block using the Large Square Squared Tool! Participants will create (4) 10" blocks to form a stunning table topper. A cutting chart is provided below, showing the color and background placement, but feel free to swap them to customize your project. Whether you stick with the suggested design or mix it up, you'll learn valuable tips and techniques for precise piecing and beautiful results!



Supplies:

Sewing machine in working order, thread, and basic sewing supplies. Glow Line Tape or other tool marking instrument

	Round 1	(8) 3 ¼" x 3 ¼"	
	Round 2		(16) 2" 4 ¼"

	Round 4		(16) 2" x 5 ½"
	Round 5	(16) 2" x 6 ¼"	
	Round 6		(16) 2" x 7"
	Corners	(8) 5" x 5"	

Tool: Large Square Squared

**Because we will be trimming, precision in the initial cut is less important than in the actual building of the block. $1\frac{3}{4}$ " strips will work, but you have more room with a 2" strip. With that being said, if you are stash busting you can get away with a little less than 2".
