

Shiva Artist's Paintstiks®

Identifying Paint Colors: This is a sheet to help you identify paint colors from our Shiva Matte Mini Assortment pack. Some of the darker colors are harder to identify. We suggest stenciling a little bit of the paint onto a swatch of fabric to further help you identify. For the Burnt Sienna and Burnt Umber (both browns), the Sienna has more of a red tint to it. You can see my set in the picture to the right, where I labeled each stick once it was identified. These colors are referenced in our *Little Stitcheries* patterns, so labeling each of your sticks will make following our patterns a breeze!



Using Shiva Paintstiks: These are oil paints in stick form. You simply peel off a little of the film from the top of the stick. Using a stencil brush, rub some of the paint onto the brush, and then rub the brush on a paper towel in a circular motion to get off any excess paint. (It's a pretty dry paint.) Use the same light, circular motions to add the paint to the design. You really don't need much. I start at the edges of the area to be painted and work my way in, even leaving the middle almost white in most cases. Add a little more paint on an edge where there would be shading, for instance, where one part sits "behind" another. We suggest playing around on a scrap piece of fabric before beginning on your project.
