We are so glad you are joining us for the Beginning Quilting class with Nancy! It will be a couple of very fun afternoons!

This two afternoon class will focus on the basics - reading a pattern, cutting, pressing and piecing the top of the quilt. We will be using a simple quilt pattern (which is included!) for a crib size quilt. You bring your fabric (6 fat quarters), thread, your sewing machine and tools!

The class starts at 10am and you may arrive as early as 9:45 to get set up.

Nancy has been deeply involved in the quilting community in the DFW area for many years and has had several quilts exhibited at the Dallas and Plano quilt shows. She worked for several years at Sew Lets Quilt It in Dallas before joining Fabric Fanatics in the spring of 2024. She also is a long time Jazzercise instructor in the area!

Fabric and Supplies Needed:

Provided in class:

- Pattern

Fabric to bring:

- Six (6) Fat Quarters (18"x 22") that coordinate

Supplies to bring:

- Sewing machine ready to sew (with 1/4" foot, regular presser foot and Walking Foot)
- Thread – light colored
- Rotary Cutter (45mm) (multiple cutting mats available to share)
- Ruler - 6"x 24" recommended
- Small iron and mat (Optional - irons and boards available to share)
- Pins or clips
- Seam ripper
- Small scissors (for snipping threads)
- Pen and paper for taking notes
