

Sew Liberated Strata Quilt Top Hack

A boxy, quilted top

Supplies:

- [Sew Liberated Strata pattern](#)- Bring a traced and cut copy of the pattern in your size along with the instructions.**
- Sewing Machine- Must know how to thread and operate prior to class.
- Coordinating or matching thread
- [Fabric Cutting Scissors](#)
- Cutter Quilt, minimum twin size, or prequilted fabric
- Sewing Pins or [Clips](#)
- [Seam Ripper](#)
- 1 ½ to 2 Yards Binding***
- [Chalk](#), disappearing or erasable marking pen- NOT Frixion, test on scrap fabric and make sure it will wash away
- [Hem Ruler/Gauge or Hot Hemmer](#)
- [Large Quilting Ruler](#)
- [Pattern Tracing Paper](#) or Scraps

Optional:

Sewing Ham
Quilting Foot
Edge Foot/Topstitch Foot
Extra Bobbins
Pinking Shears
Rubber Mallet
Rotary Blade
Extra thread
Dressmaker Curve Ruler
Sewing Label or Ribbon

Please arrive early so that we may begin promptly at the scheduled time.

**If you are not confident on sizing, we will confirm sizing the first part of class. Make a quick muslin and bring it to class along with your pattern pieces to make adjustments if needed.

***Binding is for the hem. If you prefer to bind your neckline and arms, you will need to make additional binding. Plan accordingly. Cut strips 2 ½" tall by the width of your fabric. You may need one or two strips, depending on the width of your hemline. If you want to bind your armscye and neck and need assistance cutting BIAS binding, bring at least a fat quarter size cut of fabric for your binding to class.
