



Block 1 Cutting Instructions

From the pink print cut:


A (5) 3" squares

B (20) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles

C (20) 1 3/4" squares

From the red print cut:

D (40) 1 3/4" squares



5 1/2" unfinished block Make 4 Block 2

Block 2 Cutting Instructions

From the pink print cut:

E (8) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles

F (8) 2 1/2" squares

G (32) 1 3/4" squares

From the red print cut:

H (16) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles

J (8) 2 1/2" squares

K (8) 1 3/4" squares

Cutting Instructions for the rest of the quilt

From the red print cut:

Border 1:

(2) 1 1/2" x 17 1/2" inside top and bottom borders

From the pink print cut:



Block 1


Making the Flying Geese Units

- Using a pencil, draw a straight line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a red square (D.)
- With right sides together (RST), place a red square (D) onto a pink rectangle (B). See diagram 1.
- Sew on the pencil line and trim leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- Press to the dark. See diagram 2.
- Repeat, adding another red square (D) onto the pink rectangle (B), sew and trim.. See diagram 3.
- Make a total of 20 flying geese units.



Constructing Block 1


- Sew 4 pink C squares, 4 B/D flying geese block units, and 1 pink A square together into 3 rows. Press as indicated by arrows.
- Sew the rows together. See diagram 4.
- Press seams to row 2.
- Repeat for a total of 5 Block 1.




Block 2

Making the Flying Geese Units

- Using a pencil, draw a straight line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a pink square (G).
- With right sides together (RST), place a pink square (G) onto a red rectangle (H). See diagram
- Sew on the pencil line and trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Press to the light. See diagram 6.
- Repeat, adding another pink square (G) onto the red rectangle (H), sew and trim.. See diagram 7.
- Make a total of 16 flying geese units.









Making the Half-square Triangles


- With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a pink square (F).
- Place a pink square (F) and a red square (J) right sides together.
- Sew 1/4" on either side of the pencil line. See diagram 8.
- Cut on the pencil line. See diagram 9.
- Press to the dark. See diagram 10.
- Trim to 1 3/4" square.


Note: (1) F square + (1) J square = (2) F/J half-square triangles.

Repeat for a total of (16) F/J half-square triangles.










Making Side Units 1 and 2

- Using a pencil, draw a straight line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a red square (K.)
- With right sides together (RST), place a red square (K) onto a pink rectangle (E). See diagram 11.
- Sew on the pencil line and trim leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- Press to the dark. See diagram 12.
- Make a total of 4 Side Unit 1.
- Repeat. See diagrams 13 and 14.
- Make a total of 4 Side Unit 2.








Making the Left and Right Side Block Units

- Sew 2 F/J half-square triangles and 1 E/K side unit together. Press as indicated. See diagram 15. Make a total of 4 Left Side Block units.
- Sew 2 F/J half-square triangles and 1 E/K side unit together. Press as indicated. See diagram 16. Make a total of 4 Right Side Block units.



Making the Center Flying Geese Units

- Sew 4 different G/H Flying Geese together. Press as indicated. See diagram 17.
- Make a total of 4 Center Flying Geese units.




Constructing Block 2

- Sew 1 Center Flying Geese unit, 1 Right Side Block unit and 1 Left Side Block unit.
- Press as indicated by arrows. See diagrams 18 and 19.
- Repeat for a total of 4 Block 2.





Constructing the quilt

- Use the following diagram as a guide to assemble your quilt.
- · Add the borders last.



Yardage Requirements

- 1 yard pink print for pieced blocks and outside border
- 3/8 yard red print for pieced blocks and inside border
- 1/4 yard for binding
- 1 yard for backing
