



THE CLEANING AND CARE OF YOUR FEATHERWEIGHT CLASS DESCRIPTION

We would like to introduce you to our workshop on Featherweight Care. These are hands on classes that most featherweight owners are going to want to take.

We will disassemble the machine, cleaning each area as we go, and then oiling and lubricating in the areas that are pointed out in your book or our handouts.

We will emphasize the bobbin area showing where the threads collect and make sure that each class member understands the importance of cleaning out the needle plate area on a regular basis. We also teach you how to give your machine a protective finish and clean up a case that has an odor.





SUPPLY LIST

- 1. Your Featherweight Machine
- 2. WD-40 with spray tube
- 3. Light oil (in 1/2 oz tune) with extended tip **
- 4. Singer lubricant**
- 5. Large bath towel
- 6. Screwdrivers: we recommend a 3/32-1/2", also a 3/16" and a wide bladed screwdriver**
- 7. 2 pieces of netting/tulle, cut 2" x 10"
- 8. Flashlight
- 9. Magnet or small cup
- 10. Wooden skewers
- 11. Tweezers**
- 12. Q-tips
- 13. Toothbrush
- 14. Blue paper shop towels found in the automotive department of your local discount store
- 15. White or light blue thread, Gutterman or Mettler**
- 16. Fabric to sew on
- 17. Something to protect your clothing
- 18. Extension cord (optional)
- 19. Chenille craft stems (pipe cleaners)
- 20. Scissors**
- 21. New needle
