

Embroidery Recipe Box



Dimensional Tree with High Loft Fleece on a Tee Towel

This project will create a 3 dimensional tree on a tee towel. We will use Floriani High Loft Fleece to create a dimensional embroidery design.

Supplies needed are:

- Floriani Perfect Stick Tearaway
- Floriani High Loft Dimensional Topping
- Matching Embroidery Thread top and bottom (optional)
- Tee Towel to sew on



Tip if you match the top and bottom thread the back side of the towel will look nicer. This is optional as the inside is considered the back side and the tear away stabilizer will show anyway.

- 1) To begin you hoop sticky tearaway stabilizer with the paper up and then remove the paper to expose the sticky.
 - 2) Fold the tee towel in half with the front facing together so you are looking at the back side of the towel.
- Tip look for the tag if your not sure what is the back side.

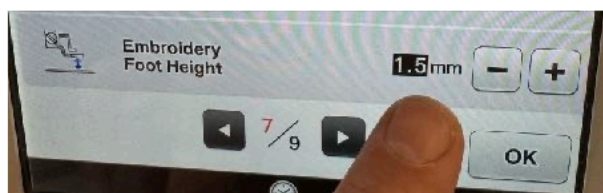
3) Place the fold of the tee towel along the centre line of your hoop and stick down to the sticky tearaway stabilizer.

Tip most hoops have an alignment marks to tell you where the horizontal and vertical centre line is.

4) Open the towel and stick the other side down to the sticky tearaway stabilizer. You are now looking at the front of your towel and it is smoothly stuck all around your embroidery hoop.



Note you should raise the height of the embroidery foot to account for the thickness of your towel and topping so it will not drag and move the topping when sewing or moving between design elements.



5) Cut a piece of Floriani High Loft Dimensional Topping the size of the hoop area.

6) Place the high loft topping on top of the towel and use some Embroidery Perfection tape to hold in place.

- 7) Embroider directly on top of the high loft topping and complete sewing the design.
- 8) When complete remove from the embroidery hoop and then peel back the sticky stabilizer from the back of the towel.
- 9) Tear away the stabilizer by resting a finger over the embroidery and then tearing against the stitches to remove the excess.
- 10) Wash the teal towel in warm water to remove the high loft topping and the embroidery will be puffy because the satin stitches have captured some of the topping inside of the embroidery.
