Flying Geese Units

4-At-A-Time ('No-Waste')

FLYING GEESE

TECHNIQUE COMMENTS: 4 FGUs (No-Waste)

Flying Geese Units (FGUs) are beautiful V-shaped elements that show up in many quilt designs, with various sizes, colorations, and arrangements. This method makes quick work of making FGUs *en masse*, with speed & accuracy and no waste!

Suggested Tools:
Quick Quarter Tool
Wing Clipper Ruler

PREP WORK

For the SS2020 quilt, there are a total of 28 Flying Geese Units (3-1/2" x 2" each). These were split over April (8), May (8), & June (12).

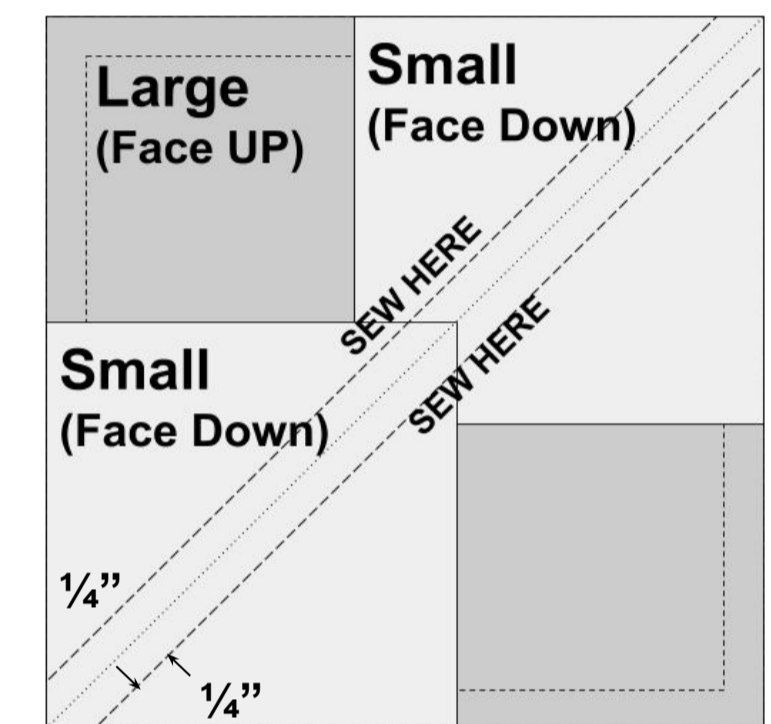
Cut the following pieces:

FABRIC	USAGE	CUT LIST
A	Body	7 Squares - 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"
B	Wings	28 Squares - 2-5/8" x 2-5/8"

Note:
Each set of 4 FGUs uses: 1 large + 4 small squares

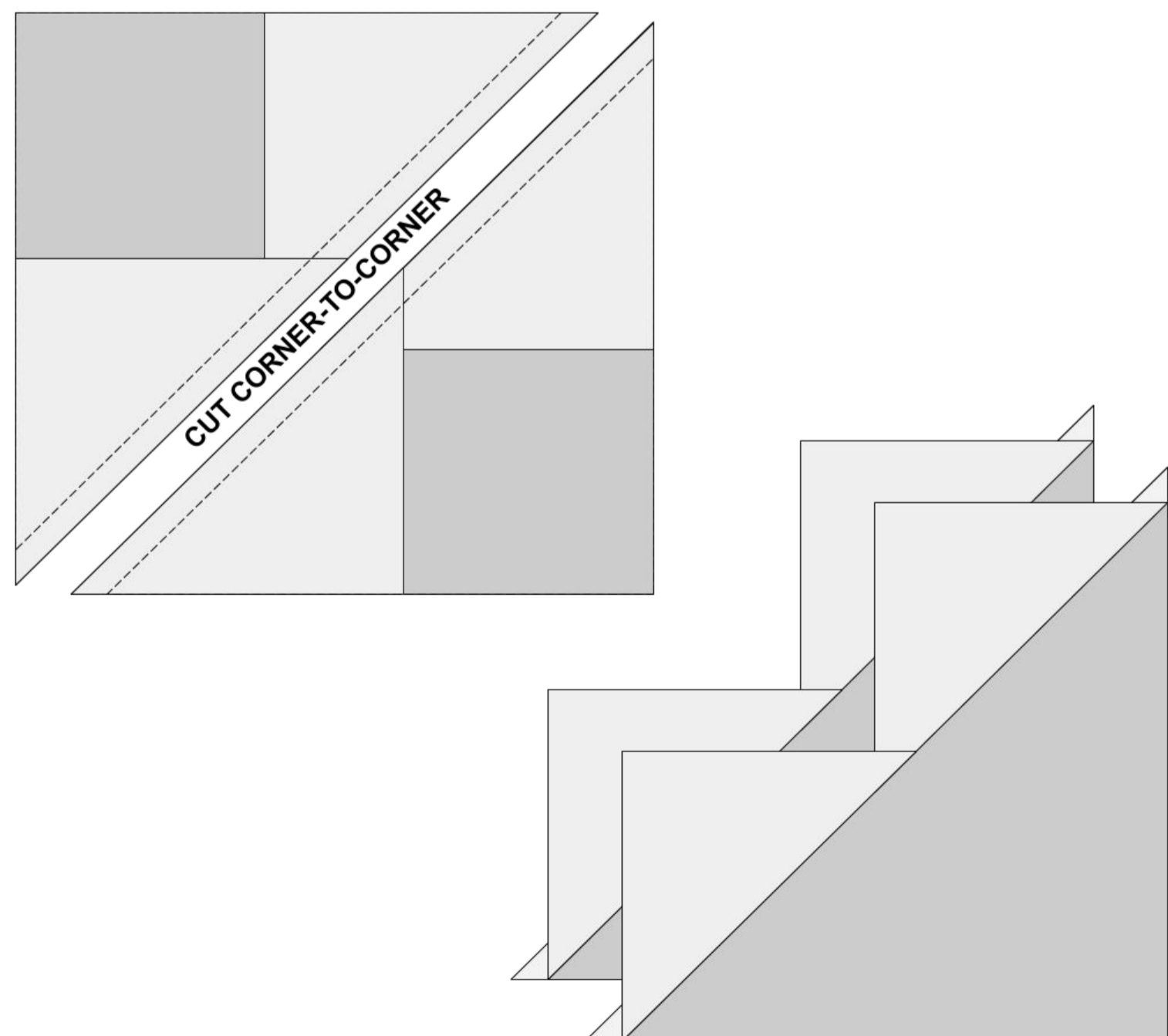
LAYOUT

Lay large square face-up, with 2 small squares aligned in opposite corners. Draw a diagonal line (*Quick Quarter Tool*), Sew a *scant 1/4"* along either side of the line.



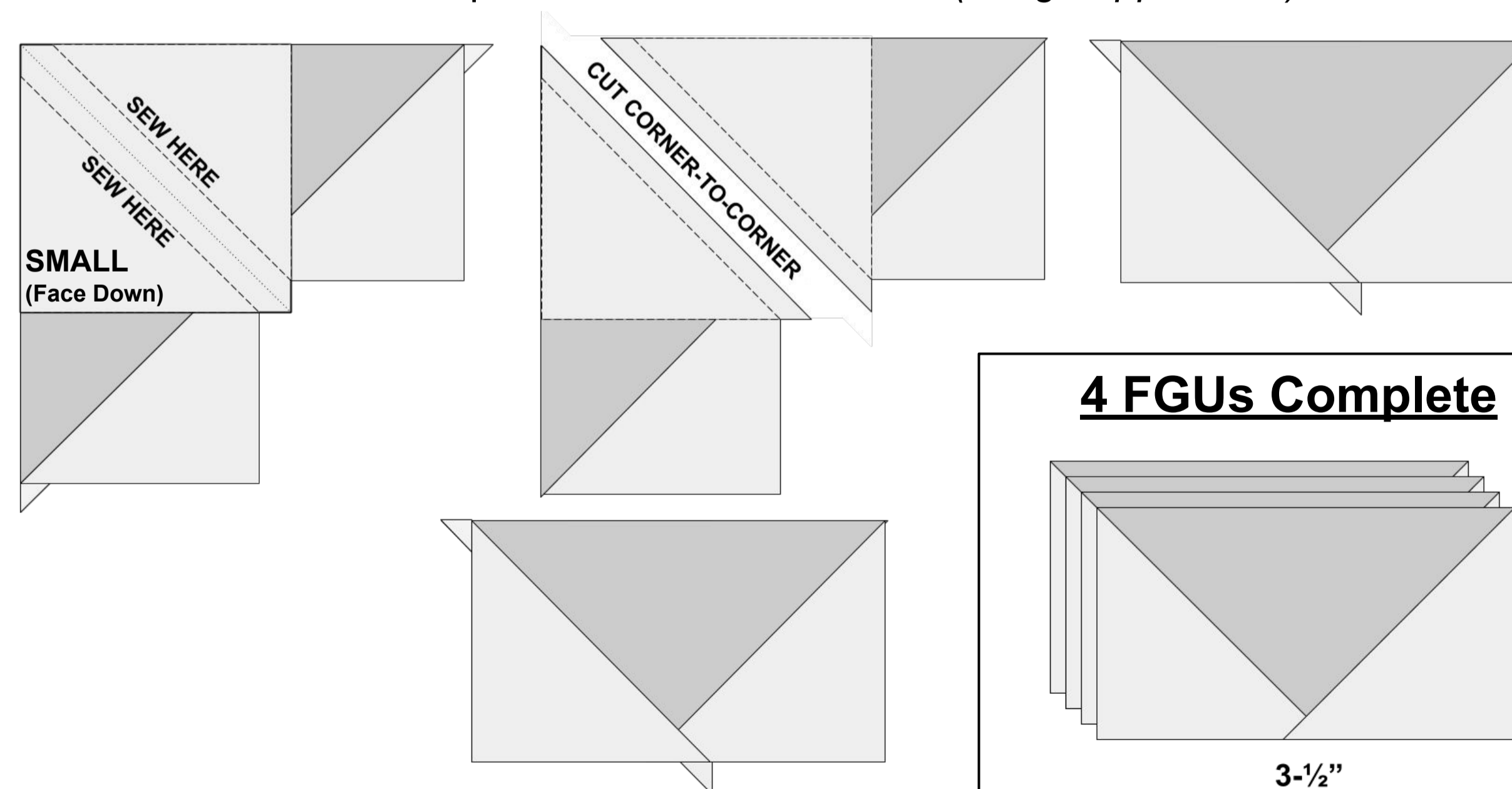
DIVIDE & CONQUER!

Cut along the diagonal line, separating the two halves
Press open the seams (see the cat ears!)



'V' IS FOR VICTORY!

Lay a small square face down, aligned with corner
Draw a diagonal line & sew a scant 1/4" seam to either side of the line.
Divide along the diagonal line & Iron open - *Repeat with the other half*
Trim & Square all FGUs to 3-1/2" x 2" (*Wing Clipper ruler*)
