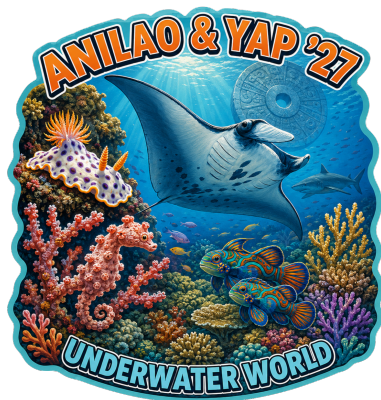

Two Legendary Pacific Dive Destinations in One Unforgettable Trip

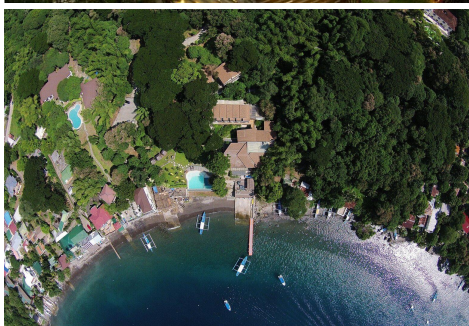
Anilao and Yap offer a rare combination of two completely different Pacific diving experiences in one unforgettable trip. Anilao, located in the heart of the Coral Triangle, is one of the world's premier destinations for macro photography, muck diving, and blackwater diving. Search the reef for nudibranchs, frogfish, pygmy seahorses, ghost pipefish, flamboyant cuttlefish, and countless other tiny marine treasures hiding among vibrant coral gardens. After Anilao, the adventure continues to Yap, a remote Micronesian island known for resident manta rays, healthy shark populations, hard coral reefs, and uncrowded dive sites. Glide through manta cleaning stations at M'il Channel and Stamtisch, experience shark encounters at Vertigo, explore dramatic reef formations at Yap Caverns, and watch the colorful mandarin fish courtship dives at Rainbow Reef.

More about Anilao and Yap

What is blackwater diving?

Blackwater diving is a nighttime open-water dive where divers look for strange and beautiful larval marine life drifting up from the deep, including jellyfish, larval fish, tiny squid, and translucent creatures that often look otherworldly.

What makes Yap culturally unique?

Yap is known for preserving many traditional customs, including its famous stone money, traditional village life, and strong local heritage. It offers a rare opportunity to experience a Pacific island culture that still feels authentic and deeply rooted.

Is this trip good for photographers?
