

Diving Fiji

Fiji, the Soft Coral Capital of the World, offers some of the most colorful and diverse diving on the planet. Neon pink, purple, and gold soft corals blanket bommies, walls, and ridgelines as clouds of anthias drift in the current. From the legendary Rainbow Reef and its Great White Wall to the shark-filled passages of Beqa Lagoon and the vibrant pinnacles of the Bligh Waters, every region reveals a new signature experience.

Calm coral gardens, dramatic drifts, shark encounters, and deep-water walls make Fiji ideal for both new and seasoned divers. Each stop on this expedition—Volivoli, Waidroka, and Paradise Taveuni—adds a unique flavor: Suncoast soft corals, Coral Coast shark action, and Taveuni's world-famous currents and reef systems. Every day brings a new site, a new burst of color, and a deeper appreciation for Fiji's extraordinary underwater world.

Continuing south, **Waidroka Bay Resort** offers a tranquil rainforest setting, oceanfront bures, communal dining, and access to Beqa Lagoon's hard-coral mazes and famous shark dives. Our adventure ends at **Paradise Taveuni**, a boutique property above the Somo Somo Strait featuring oceanfront bures, lush gardens, and direct entry to Rainbow Reef. Together, these three resorts deliver warm Fijian hospitality, stunning scenery, and effortless access to the country's most colorful and diverse diving.

More about Fiji

What's the diving like in November?

November sits at the start of Fiji's warm season, bringing calm seas, excellent visibility, and blooming soft corals across Bligh Waters, Beqa Lagoon, and the Rainbow Reef. Expect vibrant walls, gentle drifts, reef sharks, turtles, and some of the Pacific's richest biodiversity.

Where exactly is Fiji?

Fiji is a South Pacific island nation made up of 330 islands east of Australia. Our trip spans three of its premier regions, Viti Levu's Suncoast and Coral Coast, and the island of Taveuni, each known for dramatic coral formations, friendly local culture, and laid-back tropical beauty.

How do I get to Fiji?

Fly into Nadi International Airport (NAN). Fiji Airways offers service from LAX and SFO, with easy connections from major U.S. hubs. All resort transfers are included, and our final week includes a short domestic flight to Taveuni for access to Rainbow Reef.
