



RULER & MAT BAG (21X26)

Fabric Strips, Lining, Pockets, Fusible interfacing, webbing, batting. We will not BIND ours; we will do face-to-face constructions. Check the pattern for amounts. Mats, large rulers, etc. fit in this bag.



- Sewing machine; pedal, cords and manual. Your sewing tools!
Walking foot makes this easier for the thickness.
- PATTERN: POCKET FULL OF RULES, Bella Nonna #156
 - Note: This is a FREE Downloadable pattern. Do it before class.
- Rotary cutters small cutting (24 inch) mat for your table
- Ruler (6x24)
- 50 weight cotton thread, neutral
- Iron and ironing surface for your table.
- 90/14 needle for machine. (top stitching needles or Denim needle helpful)
- Fabric markers or chalk; dark and light
- Binding clips very helpful.

- Decorative threads as desired: we can use our decorative stitches
- Superior Mono-poly thread (clear), or use a light grey Bobbin=grey
- **Walking foot attachment placed** on your machine after strips are complete. A must for the thickness of the sewing on the bag.

FABRICS: NOTE TO LABEL EVERYTHING...makes your life easier!

- FOR FRONT & BAG OF BAG: 35-40 strips of different, coordinating fabrics for each side (each strip should be about 23 inches, and you may piece them if you want. You can use a jelly roll or cut different widths, from 1.5 to 3.5 inches. No fat quarters for this. We will NOT be binding this except for the tops; I have different helpful instructions.

CLASS PREPARATION:

- ❖ Bring all supplies as listed, with your machine and sewing tools.
- ❖ Check the list and purchase the pattern and needed fabric and supplies on back of pattern. PLEASE NOTE: LINING: May be Muslin or colored fabric. FUSIBLE INTERFACING: It is Décor Bond but may be substituted with a second level of interfacing as desired. BATTING: Fusible fleece. (Bosal (foam) is too thick)
- ❖ Copy your pattern for note taking. (you may want to make as gifts)
 - Come to class with all Fabrics cut and marked; bag and label: (page 1 and first three items on page 2 of the pattern. This includes : The two fusible Fusible Fleece Pieces cut. The Décor Bond or ? pieces cut and marked. Remaining pieces

Bring your walking foot on your machine (if you have one) for use in class. Easier to sew. NOTE: If you want to sew before class, just sew the first step, putting the strips together for two sides to create a 22x27 size (x2 for two sides). Otherwise wait. Questions? TEXT 480-272-4360 Gail
