Allison Skirt – Knit or Woven with Jeannine Heller

Pattern: Style Arc Allison Skirt pattern in your size range

Supplies needed:

- Sewing machine in good working order with new needle, Serger optional
- Basic sewing kit to include: Rotary cutter, and/or scissors, tape measure, thread snips/clips, marking tools: chalk, powdered marker, etc.; thread to match fabric, glass headed pins (ballpoint if using knits), new needles for sewing and/or serger (ballpoint, jersey, or stretch for knits), tape measure, shaped & straight rulers at least 24" long, #2 soft-lead pencil, scotch tape.
- Tracing medium: Swedish tracing paper or Pattern Ease or Pellon 830– available @ BC or Pellon Grided pattern medium – enough to trace the front and back
- Yardage enough for skirt in either knit or woven, preshrunk and pressed
- Come to first session prepared to take measurements on lower torso – snug fitting yoga shorts, etc.
- Yardage for the skirt must be 58" wide to insure the front and/or back skirt panels can be cut without a seam in the panel. Otherwise seams will need to be determined in the piece that is supposed to be cut on the fold.

Pre Class Preparation

- Purchase the Style Arc pattern: Allison Skirt in your size range; Trace the size closest to your hip or abdomen measurement (the larger of the two) & the length needed for your skirt, leaving adequate tracing space around the upper torso section of the pattern for waist/hip adjustments. Use tracing medium listed in the supply list – this will be used for a test fitting on your figure.

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
