## Chocolate Recipe Towel *with Mary Furniss*

**Pattern:** More Chocolate Recipes Towels by Lunchbox Quilts

### Fabric/Supplies needed:

- 100% plain high quality cotton dish towel (approx. 20" x 28") (pre-wash & ironed)
- Fabric for towel band:
  - 2" (5cm) x 24" (60cm) fabric strip
  - 1" (2.5cm) x 24" (60cm) fabric strip
- Small curved embroidery scissors
- Sticky back, Wash-away or Cut-away stabilizer
- Wash-away topper
- Can of adhesive spray for Cut-away stabilizer
- Assortment of 40 wt. polyester embroidery thread
- Bobbin thread
- Wash-away fabric marker

### Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Embroidery module with all accessories. Large Oval or Midi embroidery hoop and template
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

### Pre Class Preparation:

- Wash and iron towel

**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
