Pattern: Classic Shirt Pattern, LC018CL SZ: 0-20 cup sizes up to D
or Cashmerette Harrison Shirt CSMR2101 SZ. 12-28, cup sized up to G/H,
available at the Bernina Connection
Gents: bring a suitable shirt pattern with a collar/collar band, placket and cuff

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- Thread to match fabric
- Swedish tracing paper or Pellon 830
- Yardage for shirt, light - medium weight woven fabric, preshrunk and pressed
- **If selecting a print or plaid, purchase fabric after the first session**
- Woven interfacing - Bernina Connection has a few that are suitable for this project, NO non-woven interfacing, please!

Bring to class:

- **After first session**, bring sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking chalk or powdered marking tool, ruler, sharp pointed trimming scissors, tape measure, #2 pencil, shears, sharp glass headed pins, hand needle and contrasting silk thread and seam ripper
- Rotary cutting blade, cutting mat (if this is the method you prefer to cut with)

Pre Class Preparation:

- Purchase Classic Shirt or Harrison Shirt pattern and read and study the instructions prior to the first class
- If you want to get measurements for the upper body, come wearing or bringing smooth fitting top with no sleeves or ones that fit close to your body, like a tank top or close fitting T– top and wear the foundation that you will wear with the finished shirt.
- Yardage, thread, buttons, etc., for garment can be purchased after introductory session which covers yardage requirement for matching plaids, prints, stripes
- If you elect to learn the techniques, but do not want to make the shirt; bring fabric selections from what is stated above, but you will need the pattern for some of the pattern pieces for your samples

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
