Edge to Edge Quilting with Embroidery Machine *with Mary Lewkowitz*

Pattern: Edge to Edge Quilting on Your Embroidery Machine by Amelie Scott Designs

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- Medium size crib or lap size sandwiched quilt (no binding). Spray or pin basted.
- You may need extra fabric along the edges of your quilt if your pattern requires hooping off the edge of the quilt. Bring extra spare fabric such as muslin or fabric you aren't going to use so you can add additional space for more hoops. Approximately 1½ yards
- Threads to match/coordinate with fabric
- Pencil and paper

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with embroidery module in good working order with accessories, an extra new needle, hoop and template (mega, midi, maxi or jumbo required)
- Bring your regular presser foot #1 or #37 and embroidery foot #26
- Heavy weight stabilizer for stitching your template (enough for 2 hoopings)
- Basic sewing kit: pins, machine needles, thread cutting scissors, seam ripper, marking pencil and seam gauge
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Threads to match/coordinate with fabrics

Pre Class Preparation:

- It is essential that your quilt is sandwiched with batting and backing and spray or pin basted

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
