Bring to Class:

- ☐ Sewing machine in good working order with new needles, thread, power cord, foot control, & all of its accessories (or call the store in advance, 602.553.8350, to reserve one of ours to rent!)
- ☐ Two (2) bobbins, wound.
- ☐ Feet appropriate for project: ¼ inch foot helpful. Walking foot for quilting afterward.
- ☐ Basic Sewing Kit to include: thread, scissors, pins, slips, rotary cutter, etc.
- ☐ Rulers: Creative Grids Multi-Size 45degree/90-degree Triangle Ruler and 12-1/2 x 12-1/2 square ruler or larger.
- ☐ Ironing Pad and small iron for your station very helpful. Best Press helpful.
- ☐ Glue Pen or small tip applicator may be helpful.
- ☐ Clear Bags to put your cutting groups in and paper to label all elements.
- ☐ Fabric: Listed on Supply/Cutting Sheet. There are 6 fabrics.

Pre-class Preparation:

- ☐ If you haven't used your machine recently, we would like to suggest installing new needles and completing a brief test-sew on scrap fabric to be sure everything is running smoothly.
- ☐ Cut, bag, and identify each fabric. See Page 2 for Cutting prior to class with bags and labeling.
- ☐ Create a 'Fabric Card' showing a snip of each color, A thru E for reference.

- ☐ Confident Beginner Sewists and beyond are welcome

- **Registration:** Class fees are due at registration. Kits must be purchased before class. One week's notice is required for refunds or store credit; visiting-teacher classes are non-refundable.
- **Age-specific classes:** To keep classes focused and comfortable for everyone, adult classes are for adults only. Kids' classes are for enrolled children only; parents or guardians may not attend.
- **Machines:** All sewing machine and serger brands are welcome except in BERNINA Machine Mastery classes. Loaner machines available in class for a \$15 rental with advance registration.
- **Classroom courtesy:** Please silence cell phones during class so everyone can focus and enjoy learning. Our classroom temperature may vary, so dressing in layers is recommended.
- **Supplies:** Please label personal tools (rulers, scissors, etc.) to avoid mix-ups.
- **Lunch:** You may bring your lunch (refrigerator available) or join a group order from a local restaurant at your expense.

By the Way: Please arrive early. It is important to have all your materials and your sewing machine set up before class begins. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.

SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR CLASS:

- Your machine, pedal and cords. Manual always helpful. Clean & good working order.
- New needle in machine; Two (2) bobbins wound.
- Feet appropriate for project: ¼ inch foot helpful. Walking foot for quilting afterward.
- Basic Sewing Kit to include: thread, scissors, pins, slips, rotary cutter, etc.
- Rulers: Creative Grids Multi-Size 45degree/90-degree Triangle Ruler and
 - 12-1/2 x 12-1/2 square ruler or larger.
- Ironing Pad and small iron for your station very helpful. Best Press helpful.
- Glue Pen or small tip applicator may be helpful.
- Clear Bags to put your cutting groups in and paper to label all elements.
- Fabric: Listed on Supply/Cutting Sheet. There are 6 fabrics.

PREPARATION BEFORE CLASS:

- Cut, bag and identify each fabric. See Page 2 for Cutting prior to class with bags and labeling.
- Create a 'Fabric Card' showing a snip of each color, A thru E for reference.

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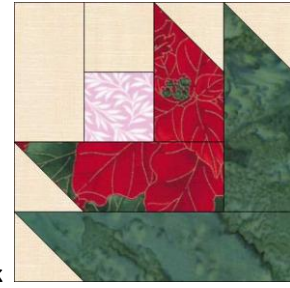
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PAGE TWO 2025 LOG CABIN WREATH FOR CLASS PREPARATION



Large Block

Center plus 3 Logs Make 4 blocks each 10 ½" x 10 ½"



Small Block

Center plus 2 Logs Make 16 blocks each 6 ½" x 6 ½"

Yardage: I recommend washing & pressing fabric to avoid distortion and running colors (REDs) when pressing during construction.

Letter	Description	Yardage	Color in Example
A	Background	1 ¼ yard	Beige / Cream (Note: ¼ yard extra)
B	Center (RED for both)	1 Fat Qtr	Red / Pink
C	Log 2 Large Block	1 Fat Qtr	Light / Medium Green
D	Log 2 Small Block	1 Fat Qtr	Red & Green Fabric
E	Log 3 Large & Small Blocks	¾ yard	Medium to Dark Green (Note: Extra)
F	Log 4 Large Block	½ yard	Darkest Green or Print with black background
	Binding	1/3 yard	Your choice

Fabric Preparation and Label: Trim Selvage before cutting strips
