Book: Edge-to-Edge Quilting on Your Embroidery Machine by Amelie Scott Designs

Bring to Class:

- Embroidery machine in good working order with new needles, thread, power cord, foot control, & all of its accessories an extra new needle, hoop and hoop template (mega, midi, maxi, or Jumbo required)
- Fabric needed:
 - Small to Medium sandwiched quilt (no binding). Spray or pin basted
 - Whole cloth – Non or small print fabric (approximately one and 1/8 yards) that has been sandwiched with batting and backing. Spray or pin basted.
 - You may need to add extra fabric along the edges of your quilt if your pattern requires hooping off the edge of the quilt. Bring extra spare fabric such as muslin or other fabric you aren't going to use so you can add additional space for more hoops. Approximately 1 and ½ yards.
- Bring your regular sewing presser foot #1 or #37 and embroidery foot #26
- Two Heavy weight stabilizers for stitching your templates
- Basic sewing kit:
 - pins,
 - machine needles,
 - thread cutting scissors,
 - seam ripper,
 - marking pencil,
 - seam gauge
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Threads to match/coordinate with fabrics
- Pencil and paper

Pre-class Preparation:

- Load your chosen design on your machine
- It is essential that your practice quilt is sandwiched with batting and backing and spray or pin basted.

Skill Level: Beginner Sewists and beyond are welcome

- **Registration:** Class fees are due at registration. Kits must be purchased before class. One week's notice is required for refunds or store credit; visiting-teacher classes are non-refundable.
