Fabric/Supplies needed:

* Patchwork pieces from 12 different fabrics. Cut from each fabric: (3) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares and (2) 1 1/2" x 2 1/4" rectangles. Total of 60 patchwork pieces; 5 per fabric type.

* Unbleached muslin: Cut (1) 7" x 9" rectangle (5" x 8" if using for 5 Panel Hat Workshop)

* Pellon P44F lightweight on-sided fusible interfacing: Cut (1) 7" x 9" rectangle (5" x 8" if using for 5 Panel Hat Workshop)

* White crochet thread: 13 yards, weight 10, 100% mercerized cotton, 3-ply

* Size 2 crewel needle

(3) silicone needle pullers to fit on your thumb, pointer finger and middle finger. These are not the same as rubber thimbles.

Scissors or snips

Clover Embroidery Needle Threader (optional): This item is uniquely designed to help thread needles with thicker thread.

Long straight pins with a ball end

Fabric marking pen or pencil: One for light fabrics and one for dark fabrics.

Clear quilter's ruler approximately 9-12" in length and no more than 2-3" wide

Top machine sewing thread that contrasts with the colors of your chosen fabrics

Bobbin thread that contrasts with unbleached muslin

Sewing machine in good working condition

* These items are available in an optional kit that can be purchased the day of class.

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
