Pattern: A Wreath for All Seasons by Vanessa Fromm

Fabric/Supplies needed:

Pillow Front

- 20” square of background fabric
- Fabric scraps for wreath leaves and elements
- 20” square of batting (optional)
- 20” square of muslin (optional)

Pillow Back

- Two 9½” x 19” pieces of fabric
- One 3½” x 19” piece of fabric for zipper flap
- Two 1½” x 4½” piece of fabric for zipper tabs
- Twenty four 2¾” x 5½” strips of fabric for rushed piping (*cover pillows used 3 strips each of 8 different fabrics*)
- 1¾ yard of fusible interfacing (Pellon SF101 was used for cover pillow)
- Light weight, paper backed fusible web
- Medium weight tear away stabilizer
- Zipper 20” - 22”
- 2¼ yards of 12/32 cotton cording
- 20” pillow form (fills an 18” pillow out better)
- Coordinating thread for embroidery
- 505 adhesive spray
- Water soluble pen
- Erasable pen or pencil
- Teflon pressing sheet

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.

- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Embroidery module (your choice of hoop, see pattern)
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen and pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- Personal small iron so you can iron right in the hoop, small personal ironing surface

Pre Class Preparation:

- Print out your general instructions and your instructions for hooping
- You will get more accomplished in class if you have copied your templates onto paper backed fusible webbing, ironed it onto the fabrics and cut the pieces out. Use the templates that have been provided in the pattern so that they will be the correct size

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
