**Required Pattern:** Happy Halloween CD design by Claudia Dinnell

**Fabric needed:** *(we will be concentrating on the middle square)*

- 1 yard white tone on tone background fabric
- 1 yard orange print border fabric
- 5-6 fat quarters of Halloween fabric for piecing blocks
- 1 yard fusible fleece by Pellon (44" wide)
- 3 yards backing fabric
- 52" x 52" batting
- Medium weight tearaway stabilizer
- Temporary adhesive spray
- Embroidery needles 80/12
- 40 weight embroidery thread
- 50 weight cotton thread to match the fabric for piecing
- Mary Ellen's Best Press starch
- 20½" square ruler for accurate marking & trimming or the largest square you have

**Bring to class:**

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Embroidery module with jumbo or mega hoop and grids
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissor, seam ripper and removable fabric marking pen
- Basic embroidery kit to include: small doubled curved scissors and long straight pointy tweezers
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

**Pre class preparation:**

- None

**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

## EZ Breezy Summer Girl Tote (cont.)

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**Pre class preparation:** *As you cut out each piece label it with the letters indicated below*

- \* Please cut-out the following pieces prior to class. Be sure to bring any excess fabric to class

#### **Outer fabric:**

Cut to the following sizes:

- \* 22" x 34" rectangle of fabric and quilt it to Pellon Thermolam fleece and pellon Décor Bond **(A)**
- \* Two 9" x 7½" rectangles **(B)** (interface these with French Fuse interfacing)
- \* Two 5" x 16" rectangles **(C)** (interface these with French fuse interfacing)

#### **Lining fabric:**

Cut to the following sizes:

- \* Two 16" x 20" rectangles **(D)**
- \* One 9" x 11" rectangle **(E)**
- \* One 2" x 9" rectangle **(F)** (interface with French Fuse interfacing)
- \* One 16" x 20" rectangle **(G)**

#### **Bottom fabric:**

Cut to the following size"

- \* One 12" x 20" rectangle **(H)** (interface with French Fuse interfacing)
