## Backroads Strip Quilt “2-4-1” Part 2

**Pattern:** Backroads of Coriander by Corey Yoder

### Fabric/Supplies needed:

- 6” Bloc-loc ruler or 6½” ruler with diagonal line
- 168 half square triangles from Backroads Quilt or Half Square triangles one half a background fabric and the other patterned fabric ready to be trimmed
- Thread to match fabrics
- Bernina presser foot #37
- Bernina single hole stitch plate
- Olaf turning mat (optional, but very helpful)
- Good snippers

### Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter 28 mm with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

### Pre Class Preparation:

- 168 half square triangles ready to be trimmed with 6” Block-loc ruler, or have some of them trimmed to 5½” squares. It’s easy with the 6’ Block-loc ruler
- Class Backroads Strip Quilt “2-4-1” Part 1
- Have an idea of the layout you want to do from the Backroads pattern, or Tink’s layout, or your own creation. Tink will have her computer and printer to help design a layout, if needed.

**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
