Baseball/Bomber Jacket

Pattern: McCall's 7100 (Sample is View A) all one fabric

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- XS (4-6) 1¾ yards (45" wide) 1½ yards (60" wide)
- S (8-10) 1⅞ yards (45" wide) 1½ yards (60" wide)
- M (12-14) 2 yards (45" wide) 1½ yards (60" wide)
- L (16-18) 2 yards (45" wide) 1½ yards (60" wide)
- XL (20-22) 2½ yards (45" wide) 1⅝ yards (60" wide)
- XXL (24-26) 2⅝" yards (45"wide) 1¾ yards (60" wide)
- ½ yard ribbing for collar, cuffs, bottom band (DO NOT wash or dry ribbing)
- ¾ yard Shape Flex 101 or SF 101 fusible interfacing
- 20" separating zipper for XS, S, M (do not use metal teeth for your first jacket)
- 22" separating zipper for L, XL, XXL (do not use metal teeth for your first jacket)
- Double sided basting tape
- Sewing weight thread to match fabric
- Serger thread to match fabric
- Zig Zag foot (Bernina foot #1C or 1D)
- Zipper foot (Bernina foot #4)
- Edge stitch foot (Bernina foot #10)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Serger with all accessories, power cord and foot control
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper & water soluble marking pen

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By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Pre Class Preparation:

- Select pattern size using the finished garment measurement listed on the pattern envelope. To do this, hold a tape measure around the fullest part of your bust and then let the tape out to correlate to the finished bust measurements on pattern. This will give you a better idea of the design drape and fit of the pattern.
- Wash, dry and press fabric
- Trace pattern pieces for your size onto freezer paper making sure to transfer all markings
- You can cut your fabric at home, but please leave all pattern pieces together with the cut fabric and be sure you have transferred all marking to the fabric

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
