Beginning Machine Quilting with Mary Lewkowitz

Tuition: \$40.00

Fabric needed:

- 10 – 14” squares of muslin
- 5 or more 14” squares of batting
- 5 squares of muslin cut into 4 1/2” squares
- 4 squares of medium or dark fabric cut into 4 1/2” squares

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord, presser foot, in good working order with a new needle. Machine must be able to drop the feed dogs. Bring your machine accessories along also
- Presser feet: Multipurpose foot (Bernina #1 or #34), 1/4” foot (Bernina #37 or #57), Darning foot (Bernina #9 or #24), Walking foot. *Must be able to drop machine feed dogs to do free motion sewing*
- A straight stitch plate, if you have one
- Size 70/10 and 75/11 sharp or quilting needles (Schmetz needles are recommended) – no ballpoint
- Basic sewing kit: including pins, thread clips, scissors, seam ripper, blue water soluble marking pen etc.
- 50 wt. 100% cotton sewing thread that matches muslin (I recommend Aurifil or Mettler)
- 1” rustproof safety pins (a handful will do) or 505 Temporary Spray Adhesive
- Quilting Halo, quilting gloves, Supreme Slider are all recommended. Bring them if you have them
- Paper and pencil for note taking

Pre class preparation:

- * Make sure your fabrics have been pressed and accurately cut
- * Mark the pattern B (on second page) onto 1 of the 14” square of muslin using a blue water soluble pen (you can place it under the muslin as you should be able to see through it to mark)

A good all around reference book is "Heirloom Machine Quilting" by Harriet Hargrave

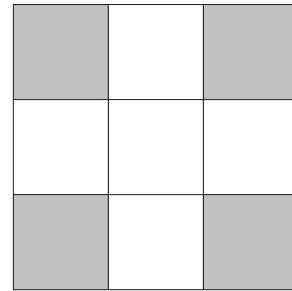
