Fabric/Supplies needed:

- \blacktriangleright #26 or #15 embroidery presser foot
- ▶ #37 quarter inch foot
- ➢ 505 spray adhesive
- \blacktriangleright 80/12 embroidery needles
- ➢ Teflon iron shield
- Mesh cutaway stabilizer, enough for 3 hooping's in the large oval hoop (steam press before class to shrink)
- Mesh water soluble stabilizer for those who <u>do not</u> have the ability to pre-cut your bats such as Aqua Mesh Plus Wash-A-Way stabilizer (OESD brand) or Wet N Gone Tacky stabilizer (Floriani brand)
- Sticky mesh water soluble stabilizer for those who have the ability to pre-cut your bats such as Aqua Mesh Wash-A-Way stabilizer (OESD brand) or Wet N Gone regular (Floriani brand)
- Point turner
- Steam a Seam 2 tape or other similar product (in the ½" width, approximately 15")
- ▶ 12" of ½" or 5/8" wide grosgrain ribbon or satin faced ribbon
- Cover up/fabric cover vinyl in white (by Hoop-it-All, Inc.)
- > 1 Trip Tic wire stand from Ackfeld Manufacturing available at Bernina Connection
- ▶ ½ yard fusible web (Heat N Bond or Transweb)
- Embroidery thread to coordinate with your chosen fabrics
- Sewing bobbin loaded with thread that coordinates with your choice of backing fabric
- ➢ Mini iron

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By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.

BRING TO CLASS:

BE SURE TO DOWNLOAD DESIGN(S) FROM THE CD IN THE PATTERN TO YOUR USB STICK

- Sewing machine in good working condition with power cord, foot control, slide tray, with a new needle.
- Embroidery module, embroidery bobbin case (if you use a different one for embroidery), large oval hoop (bring 2 if you have them), plus the mega or jumbo hoop if you have the cutwork tool
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, scissors for thread cutting and sewing shears, double curved embroidery scissors, thread snips, scotch tape, pinking shears
- ➢ Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

PRE CLASS PREPARATION:

- ¹/₃ yard fabric for the background (behind the lettering) and backing cut into Three - 5" x 9" background rectangles Six - 5" by 5" backing squares, press under ¹/₂" on <u>one</u> side of three of the rectangles
- 1 fat eight fabric for bats, cut to: Two 4" x 6" rectangles, spray with starch, press until dry and then fuse fusible web to the reverse side of one rectangle. Remove the protective paper and fuse the two 4" x 6" rectangles to back.
 Note: the fabric requires a firmer hand to look nice as 3 dimensional bats, fusing the layers back to back provides the necessary body Another option would be to fuse sparkle organza to the right side of the fabric to provide a gossamer appearance to the wings
- ¹/₄ yard fabric for the appliques BOO lettering, cut to: One 7" x 15" rectangle, spray with starch, press until dry and then fuse fusible web to the reverse side, leave the protective paper on until later. Note: If your fabric choice is a light color, I recommend backing it with a lightweight fusible interfacing prior to attaching the fusible web, in this manner a dark background won't muddy the appearance of the lettering.
- ¹/₄ yard fusible fleece (Pellon Thermolan Plus TP971K recommended) Cut into six 4¹/₈" x 7¹/₂" rectangles
