Boxed Cushions with Cecile Babich-Morrow

Tuition: \$25.00

Pattern: None

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- 1½ yards of 42” wide fabric for the cushion
- 1 yard of contrasting fabric for covered welt cord
- 1 yard uncovered welt cord
- 26” zipper
- 15” x 17” x 3” seating foam or premium densified batting
- ½ yard Dacron upholstery batting
- Permanent spray adhesive
- Thread to match fabrics
- Reverse pattern foot (Bernina #1), zipper foot (Bernina #4), or zipper foot with a guide (Bernina #14), bulky overlock foot (Bernina #12) and edgestitch foot (Bernina #10)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle, slide on tray. (*Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina*)
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins, pincushion, seam ripper and seam gauge
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool, acrylic ruler and right angle ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- Wash and dry your fabric in the manner you would care for your Jammies

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
