## Cactus Flower Table Runner *with Jackie Kunkel*

**Pattern:** Cactus Flower Table Runner pattern by Quiltworx

### Fabric/Supplies needed:

- One piece of template plastic (3" x 12" piece)
- 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler
- Purple thang
- ¼" sewing foot
- 6" x 12" ruler
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm and an extra new blade
- 70/10 Microtex needles
- Fabric glue or glue pen
- High quality sewing thread 50 wt.
- Flower pins
- Scotch tape
- Large Ziploc bags (2 gallon is best or 1 gallon)
- Stapler
- Binder clips, medium
- Large paper clips

### Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, scissors, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, medium size cutting mat (18" x 24") for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler
- Small iron with ironing surface

**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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## Pre Class Preparation:

- Pre-cut the fabrics is a **mandatory** requirement prior to taking this class. Please begin preparing for class at least 2-3 weeks prior to the class to make sure that you are able to get familiar with your pattern and complete the pre-cutting before hand. It is important that you have your pre-class cutting completed. If this step is not complete, you will have a very difficult time keeping up and participating in the instruction. First read through the entire pattern before beginning
