Fabric/Supplies needed:

- \blacktriangleright 45" wide fabric 2⁵/₈ yards for XS-M: 3¹/₄ yards for L-XXL
- \blacktriangleright 60" wide fabric 1⁷/₈ yards for XS=M: 2¹/₃ yards for L-XXL


Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Serger (optional) with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, fabric shears, seam ripper, marking pencil, seam gauge
- Sewing thread to match or coordinate with fabric
- ➢ One 1"button
- Fusible web tape (optional)

Pre Class Preparation:

- Trace your size pattern Swedish tracing paper (my favorite)
- Pin pattern onto fabric but do not cut unless you have experience in using a pattern

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
