**Pattern:** Chicago Jacket by The Sewing Workshop Collection

### Fabric/Supplies needed:

- 45" wide fabric - 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards for XS-M: 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards for L-XXL
- 60" wide fabric - 1<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards for XS=M: 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yards for L-XXL

### Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Serger (optional) with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, fabric shears, seam ripper, marking pencil, seam gauge
- Sewing thread to match or coordinate with fabric
- One 1" button
- Fusible web tape (optional)

### Pre Class Preparation:

- Trace your size pattern - Swedish tracing paper (my favorite)
- Pin pattern onto fabric but do not cut unless you have experience in using a pattern

**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
