Pattern: The Sewing Workshop: Eureka Top pattern available at the Bernina Connection

Bring to Class:

- Sewing machine in good working order with new needle, bobbins, presser foot, power cord & foot control
- Needles and bobbins, pedal, power cords (may not use class 1)
- The Sewing Workshop: Eureka Top pattern (need class 1)
 - Recommend purchasing a pattern in an envelope if available
 - Assemble pattern, if printed at home
- Fabric and Thread (to be determined in first class)
 - If you have something you might like to use, bring it to the first class
- Fabric and Paper Scissors, marking tools, pins, ruler, needles
- Tissue Paper – can be white gift wrap tissue, roll of tissue paper
- Notebook, pen, folder
- Will discuss in first class: adhesive tape

Pre-class Preparation:

- Purchase a preprinted (preferable) or assemble The Sewing Workshop: Eureka Top pattern
- If you haven't used your machine recently, we would like to suggest installing a new needle and completing a brief test-sew on scrap fabric to be sure everything is running smoothly.

- **Registration:** Class fees are due at registration. Kits must be purchased before class. One week's notice is required for refunds or store credit; visiting-teacher classes are non-refundable.
- **Age-specific classes:** To keep classes focused and comfortable for everyone, adult classes are for adults only. Kids' classes are for enrolled children only; parents or guardians may not attend.
- **Machines:** All sewing machine and serger brands are welcome except in BERNINA Machine Mastery classes. Loaner machines available in class for a \$15 rental with advance registration.
- **Classroom courtesy:** Please silence cell phones during class so everyone can focus and enjoy learning. Our classroom temperature may vary, so dressing in layers is recommended.
- **Supplies:** Please label personal tools (rulers, scissors, etc.) to avoid mix-ups.
- **Lunch:** You may bring your lunch (refrigerator available) or join a group order from a local restaurant at your expense.

By the Way: Please arrive early. It is important to have all your materials and your sewing machine set up before class begins.
