## Flower Pot Wall Hanging with Kim Serba

### **Pattern:** Flower Pot Applique Quilt by Kim McLean

Applique note: I choose to use the Steam A Seam applique technique because my goal is always to complete the quilt quickly so I can move on to my Bernina Q-24. The Steam a Seam is used for this process. You may use the applique technique you prefer – simply bring the supplies you know you will need.

Background and border fabric: Check pattern for fabric needs of your chosen design. Choose a light background that may have a pattern or textural element that will lend itself to fun free-motion quilting later.

\*If pattern is sold out, contact Kim Serba and we can determine the amount of background and border fabric you will need.

### **Fabric/Supplies needed:**

- Fat quarters if larger applique pieces or stems are in design
- Fabric scraps for applique motifs and sashing squares
- Binding fabric: can be pieced from fat quarters or ½ yard
- 1 yard Steam a Seam light
- Sharpie marker
- Marking tool that is visible and can be removed from your background fabric
- ¼” bias maker
- Small applique pins
- Small needle and neutral polyester thread
- Sharp scissors to cut paper and fabric and long straight ruler

### **Bring to class:**

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: machine needles, fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, shears, pins, seam gauge, stiletto and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler
- Small iron and ironing mat
