Foolproof Hexagon Crazy Patch

Fabric/Supplies needed: (do not pre-wash fabric)

- 12" x 12" square of good quality muslin for each Hexagon
- 12" x 12" square woven interfacing for each hexagon (*do not substitute this weight interfacing, white is fine as it will not show for the base*)
- 12" x 12" square of black cotton fabric
- 12" x 12" square of Fuse and Fleece
- Size 7 embroidery needle
- Chenille needles size 22 and 24
- Beading needle size 12 for seed beads
- Milliners #10 for most beading
- Sewing machine needle (size 80/12 or 90/14)
- Neutral and black sewing weight thread
- For hand stitching use any combination of embroidery floss, size 5, 8, 21 pearl cotton
- For machine stitching use any combination of embroidery thread, jeans top stitch thread, size 12 weight machine thread
- Beads, sequins or buttons (optional to embellish patches)
- 2 manila file folders
- Freezer paper
- #2 lead pencil
- Pressing cloth

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper and water soluble marking pen
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Pre Class Preparation:

- Trace a hexagon outline from the book onto a manila file folder using a pencil. It does not matter which hexagon outline you select from the book, as the outlines are all the same size. You do not need to trace the inside lines onto your template. Please be precise in tracing this hexagon.

Cut out the hexagon you traced using a rotary cutter to ensure smooth edges.

On the other manila folder, trace as outline of a hexagon as you did in step one above. Using a ruler and pencil, add 1 inch onto EACH of the six sides of your hexagon. Cut out this template on the outside edge.
