Fabric/Supplies needed:

- ¼ yard cuts of ten to twelve fabrics for braid. Consider a run of value (*dark to medium to light pink, for instance or a run of hues (green, green-blue, blue-green, blue-violet, violet-blue, violet...for examples)* (Each fabric will extend your quilt about 5" in length)
- ½ yard fabric for triangles (*beginning and ending triangles may be same or different*)
- ½ yard accent fabric (*should have a strong contrast to first and last fabric*)
- 24" rotary ruler, rotary cutter and cutting mat
- Thread for piecing

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- Please have your fabrics chosen before class and the sequence decided upon

To finish the quilt you will need the following (but not in class)

- 1 yard inner framing border fabric
- 2½ yards border and binding fabric
- 7 yards backing fabric
- Batting

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
