Fabric/Supplies needed:

- Two 8" x 6" squares of quilting fabric* with fusible already ironed on the back
- Two 12" x 12" squares of batik fabric* with fusible already ironed on the back
- 404 or 504 spray adhesive
- Small scissors
- Silhouette spatula or equivalent
- Pen and paper for taking notes

Bring to Class:

- Silhouette Cameo cutter PLUS all cords
- Laptop Computer with Silhouette DESIGNER Edition Version 3 loaded. This is not the software that comes with the Silhouette. This is an Upgrade!
- Silhouette cutting mat
- Silhouette blade in machine

Pre Class Preparation:

- You MUST have the upgrade Designer Edition of the Silhouette software loaded on your laptop BEFORE class. *If you do not, you will not get a hands on experience and you will have to observe a student who does have the upgraded software loaded.*
- Fabric must be starched

To prepare your fabric with starch, spray starch on one side of the fabric and then turn over and iron. Spray starch on the ironed side of the fabric and then turn over and iron. Repeat this step one more time so that you have starched the fabric 3 times. I used either Faultless Heavy starch or mix my own Sta-Flo liquid starch

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
