Pattern: “Happy Birthday” Wall Hanging or Table Tip Display by Janine Babich Designs

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- USB stick with design loaded prior to class
- 505 spray
- 80/12 sharp embroidery needles
- Bobbin fill bobbin thread
- Walking foot
- Medium weight fusible tearaway stabilizer if you have a Maxi or Jumbo hoop
- Sticky tearaway stabilizer & medium weight fusible stabilizer if you have a Mega hoop
- Embroidery threads, look at the photo/sample at the shop and your choice of border fabric and select threads that coordinate/compliment the border fabric
- 30” of $\frac{5}{8}$ ” wide rick rack/trim in a color that compliments your border fabric or make you own $\frac{1}{4}$ ” wide bias strips to use as accent strips
- $\frac{1}{3}$ yard linen for the background behind the embroider
- $\frac{1}{3}$ yard print fabric for upper & lower borders and bindings
- One $\frac{5}{8}$ ” x 30” strip or two $\frac{5}{8}$ ” x 15” strips of accent fabric for strips above and below the embroidered center section (disregard if you are using rick rack or purchased trim)
- Two 2” squares of applique fabric for the balloons
- One $2\frac{1}{2}$ ” x 3” fabric rectangle for the party hat
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard backing fabric
- One 14” x 16 rectangle of fusible fleece

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Embroidery module with all accessories: power cord, thread stand, embroidery bobbin case (if you use a different one for the embroidery process), Mega, Maxi or Jumbo embroidery hoop, #26 or #15 embroidery foot, slide on tray for 5, 7 & 8 series machines
- Basic sewing kit to include: thread snips, small curved scissors for trimming applique fabric, fabric marking device, Frixion pen preferred, straight pins
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- Be sure to download design(s) from the CD in the pattern to your USB stick prior to class
- Linen fabric - $\frac{1}{3}$ yard, cut to:
 - One 10" x 14" rectangle, fuse woven fusible interfacing to the reverse side
 - On the reverse side use a Frixion (a heat removable marker) pen to lightly draw cross hairs through the vertical and horizontal centers. Draw the vertical cross hair approximately 7" long, the horizontal approximately 3" long
- Print fabric for upper & lower borders and binding: $\frac{1}{3}$ yard, cut to:
 - Two 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF (width of fabric) strips, join end to end with a mitered seam, trim the seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ " in width, press the seam allowance open and then press the entire strip in half lengthwise to create a 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " wide binding, set aside for later
 - One 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13" strip for the upper border
 - One 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for the lower border
- Accent fabric for the $\frac{1}{4}$ " strip
 - One $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 30" strip or two $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 15" strips. Please go to page 7 for instructions on preparing the accent strip
- Applique fabric: cut to size indicated below, spray with starch, press until dry and then fuse fusible web to the reverse side. Note: to give my appliques an iridescent appearance I fused a similar colored sparkle organza to the fabrics right side.
 - Two 2" squares for the balloons
 - One 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" rectangle for the party hat
- Backing fabric: One $\frac{1}{2}$ yard, cut to:
 - One 14" x 16" rectangle for the backing
 - One 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12" rectangle for the hanging sleeve

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
