Pattern/Book: Hexi Pumpkin Patch by Debbie B Designs

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- One 15 x 15 inch background fabric
- Several scraps of orange or red fabrics for pumpkins
- Green scraps of fabrics for leaves
- Brown scrap for stem
- Scraps for spider, 2 colors (solid black, small print black)
- > 18 x 18 inch piece of fabric for backing (if you are making a quilted wall hanging)
- > 18 x 18 inch batting (if you are making a quilted wall hanging)
- Shortcut binding tool (if you are making a quilted wall hanging)
- Silver embroidery thread
- Green embroidery thread
- Aurifil thread for piecing in orange
- Manila folder to make hexagon templates or ½ inch hexagon pieces
- ► Hand sewing needle
- Red clips
- Small seed beads can be used as listed below. The shop sample used embroidery thread and french knots and no beads. Silver for web, orange for vine and white for eyes

Bring to class:

Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper, water soluble marking pen
