Hoopla Bag with Diane Mathus-Nagano

Pattern: Hoopla Bag by Bella Nonna

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- 1 1/8 yards main fabric for body, handles, loops and binding
- 2/3 yard coordinating fabric for pocket A
- 1/2 yard each of three coordinating fabrics for pockets B, C, D
- Additional fabric for optional additional pockets on reverse side
- 14" zipper for front zipper pocket
- 1/2 yard Velcro
- 1/2 yard Bosal In-R-Form single sided fusible foam
- 1/2 yard fusible fleece OR
- *For additional padding as in the store sample, 1 yard fusible fleece*
- Pins and quilt clips
- Sewing needle 80/12
- Presser feet: #57 or other 1/4" foot, #37 or #1, #10 topstitch foot
- Frixion or other fabric marker
- *Optional - grommet with an approx. 1.5" center opening for hanging*

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- Cut fabric as indicated in pattern and LABEL fabric pieces
- Omit the Décor Bond for the handle

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.

- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
