Fabric/Supplies needed:

- > 1 yard fabric (I used Bernina Connection"s wonderful linen)
- 2 yards Shape Flex fusible interfacing
- ➤ 1-20" square batting
- > 3 buttons
- ➤ Walking foot (very helpful)
- ➤ All purpose foot (#1 or #34)
- ➤ Buttonhole foot (#3A)
- ➤ Ultra clean and tear stabilizer
- > Thread to match/coordinate with fabrics
- > 505 temporary spray adhesive
- ≥ 20" square pillow form (you can put your form in at home if you wish)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle, all accessores, extra new needles
- Embroidery module with mega hoop or larger
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, scissors for clipping threads, seam ripper, removable marking pen or pencil, seam gauge, ruler, seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for using with rotary cutting tool and ruler
- Personal iron (very helpful)

Pre Class Preparation:

- > Cut one 20" square of fabric
- Adhere fusible interfacing to the back of the 20" square of fabric

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.
