Pattern: Jacobean Journey Block of the Month by HoopSisters

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- See attached fabric and thread key. Fabric quantities are determined by the size of the block chosen

Bring to class:

- Embroidery machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic embroidery kit including embroidery foot, tweezers, double curved embroidery scissors, embroidery needles, etc.
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen and pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Embroidery designs on appropriate USB stick or computer and connection cords
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler
- Thread per fabric and thread key

Pre Class Preparation:

- Purchase pattern, all fabrics and threads
- Pre cut fabrics and batting, per cutting instructions for the appropriate blocks (each session will have a set of blocks to be worked on)

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
