

# The Bernina Connection Materials List

**JOY Table Top Display**

**Required Pattern:** JOY Table Top Display by Janine Babich

## **Fabric/Supplies needed:**

- #26 or #15 embroidery presser foot
- #37 foot
- 505 spray adhesive or Web Bond
- 80/12 embroidery needles
- Teflon iron shield
- Mesh cutaway stabilizer, enough for 3 hooping in the large oval hoop (steam press before class to shrink)
- Wet N Gone stabilizer
- Point turner
- Steam a Seam, ¼" wide strips, 12"
- 12" of ½" or ⅝" wide grosgrain ribbon, green or red
- ½ yard Transweb or Wonder Under
- ¼ yard fusible fleece, cut into 6 - 4⅛" x 7½" rectangles
- Thread stand
- Sewing bobbin loaded with thread that coordinates with your choice of backing fabric

## **Bring to class:**

- **BE SURE TO DOWNLOAD DESIGN(S) FROM THE CD IN THE PATTERN TO YOUR USB STICK**
- Sewing machine in good working condition with power cord, foot control, slide tray, with a new needle.
- Embroidery module, embroidery bobbin case (if you use a different one for embroidery), large oval hoop (bring 2 if you have them), plus the mega or jumbo hoop if you have the cutwork tool
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, scissors for thread cutting and sewing shears, double curved embroidery scissors, thread snips, scotch tape, pinking shears
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Mini iron

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**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.

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- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

**Fabric Kit available for purchase from Bernina Connection, prepared as below:**

- ¼ yard of ivory Dupioni background fabric, cut into 3- 5" x 9" pieces
- ¼ yard of red Dupioni lettering fabric, spray with starch, press until dry and then cut to:
  - Cutwork owners: cut to 6" x 15" (Mega hoop owners) or 7" x 12 (Maxi or Jumbo hoop owners) and fuse Transweb to the back.
  - Non-cutwork owners: cut to 7" x 12" and fuse Transweb to the back
- ¼ yard of green Dupioni for leaves, spray with starch, press until dry and then cut
  - Cutwork owners: cut into 4- 5" x 5" rectangles and then fuse back to back with fusible web.
  - Non-cutwork owners: cut into 2- 5" x 10" rectangles and then fuse back to back with fusible web.

**Not in kit:** ¼ yard backing fabric, cut into 6 – 5 ½" x 5" rectangles (I used a cotton quilting fabric), press ½" to the reverse side along one 5 ½" side of 3 of the squares.

**Thread:**

- Embroidery thread to match the ivory background fabric
- Embroidery thread to match the red lettering fabric
- Embroidery thread to match the green leaf fabric
- Embroidery thread for gold berries

**Pre class preparation:**

**Not in kit:** ¼ yard backing fabric cut into 6 - 5" squares. I used a cotton quilting fabric, press under ½" along one side of 3 of the squares
