- Fat quarter or scraps to equal at least a fat quarter for the candle \triangleright
- $\frac{1}{8}$ yard or scraps at least 2" x 2" for flame
- AAAAAA ¹/₂ yard complementary fabric or sold for the background
- ¹/₄ yard fabric of your choice for binding
- Fat quarter or a little larger for batting
- Fat quarter or a little larger for backing
- Graph paper or grid composition book
- Color pencils or crayons in basic colors
- Thread to match fabrics

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good \geq working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for \geq clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler \triangleright (6" x 24" ruler)
