Pattern: Will be supplied at class

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- 1/3 yd Fabric A
- 1/2 yd Fabric B
- 2/3 yd Fabric C
- 3/4 yd Fabric D
- 1 yd Fabric E
- 1 1/4 yds Fabric F
- 1 1/3 yds Fabric G
- 1 1/2 yds for chain and 1st border
- 1 1/2 yds for 2nd border

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, medium size cutting mat (18" x 24") for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler to cut strips
- 50 wt neutral thread for piecing (I like Aurifil 50 wt)

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Log Cabin Chain Cutting Instructions

If you can arrive at class with at least two of each of the strips cut you will be able to complete a number of blocks while in class. Strips are cut from the width of the fabric and will measure approximately 42" long, depending on the width of your fabric.

Cut from each fabric:

Chain fabric - Sixteen 2" strips

Fabric A - Four 2" strips

Fabric B - Four 3 ½" strips

Fabric C - Four 5" strips

Fabric D - Four 6 ½" strips

Fabric E - Four 8" strips

Fabric F - Four 9 ½" strips

Fabric G - Four 11" strips

Please bring the strips you have cut and all the remaining fabric to class.

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
