Fabric/Supplies needed:

- USB stick with your name on it (*have plenty of room on your USB stick*)
- 2 yards Background fabric white, tan or cream tone on tone or small print
Additional fabric amounts for borders will be given in class
- Embroidery feet #9 or #15 are preferred or #26
- Embroidery bobbin case
- Isacord thread (bring any colors you want to use)
I used Red #1911 Blue #3543 Black #0020, & Gray #4073.
- Ultra Clean and Tear medium weight stabilizer
- Heavyweight tearaway stabilizer
- 505 temporary spray
- Embroidery needles #80 sharp
- Double sided tape by Scotch Brand (not repositionable)
- Arrow shaped post it notes

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Embroidery module, large, mega and or jumbo hoops and grids with the little gray handles (*bring largest hoop and grid that you have*)
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen, ruler, pins, seam ripper, tweezers, sharp curved scissors, pins
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool, and ruler

Pre Class Preparation: None

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
