Pattern/Book: Market Street Handbag by Kenzie Mac & Co.

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- > ³/₄ yard exterior and binding fabric
- ➤ ½ yard lining fabric
- ➤ 1 fat quarter for inside pocket
- Soft and Stable (headliner) 2 pieces at least 22" x 18"
- \triangleright 1½ yards Jute Upholstery webbing (3½" wide or 2½ yards webbing for handle
- Freezer or pattern paper
- > 50 weight thread to match fabric
- > Thread to match jute or handle webbing
- ➤ Size 90/14 sewing machine needle to sew jute or webbing
- ➤ Size 80/12 sewing machine needle for bag construction

Fabric/Supplies needed for muslin flower:

- > 2 strips of good quality muslin each measuring 2" wide by the width of the fabric
- One piece of good quality muslin measuring 3" wide by 6" long
- ➤ #37 or #37D quarter inch sewing foot
- Sewing weight thread to match muslin
- > One button for flower center
- ➤ Hand sewing needle, size 7 embroidery works nicely

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper, water soluble marking pen
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, ruler and mat for use with rotary cutting tool
