Men's Golf Shoe Tote

Pattern: NEED PATTERN NAME

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- 1¼ yards vinyl mesh fabric (sample was made with 1 yard of colored vinyl mesh and ¼ yard of black vinyl mesh)
- One 4" x 6" piece of black cotton fabric fused with woven interfacing (match cotton fabric color to color of zipper)
- Sewing thread to match color or contrast vinyl mesh fabric
- One size 5/02 nylon coil zipper (the kind that comes on a roll or single zipper at least 18" long) (metal zipper will NOT work for this pattern)
- Clover red clips or clothes pins to hold bag to sew
- 1 extra large eyelet 7/16" (Dritz has these in a pack of 10)
- One Carabineer clip model is 3" long (found at Lowes near ropes and pulleys)
- Freezer paper for pattern construction
- Black sewing thread

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper, and water soluble pen or pencil
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- Draw pattern pieces on freezer paper and cut paper before class

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Lynn's Hexagon Evening Bag

Pre Class Preparation:

- Have 2 completed hexagon blacks made that measure approximately $4\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side. These will be the front and back of your bag.
- Cut one strip of black fabric to measure the width of the fabric (do not cut off selvages) by 4" wide. Fuse black interfacing to the wrong side of this piece of fabric.
- Cut one strip of black fabric 4" wide by the width of the fabric (do not cut off selvages) Do not fuse anything to this strip.
- Cut 2 strips of fabric $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by 20" long and fuse black woven interfacing to these pieces.

* Note: The front of the bag is made from two finished hexagons. The pattern for the hexagon is in the book Foolproof Crazy Quilting by Jennifer Clouston 2013. If you did not take the class for the base, you will need to construct a front and back hexagon block measuring $4\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side including the binding and bring to class.

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
