Pattern: Old St Nick by Betty Alderman

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- > 1 yard fabric for background and binding
- → ¼ yard different print fabric for inner border
- yard light print fabric for top and bottom outer border
- I yard very different light print fabric for outer border sides, coat and hat trim
- 1/4 yard red print fabric for coat and hat
- Bring additional print scraps for clothing, bag, bird, stars, face and corner set squares
- 1/4 yard green print fabric for tree and stars
- Scrap of dark fabric for shoes
- > 2 yards fusible web
- ≥ 30" x 34" batting for backing fabric

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle and bring several filled bobbins
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, large fabric scissors, sharp pointed small scissors, marking pencil, seam gauge
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool, and ruler
- Thread to match or coordinate with fabrics
- ► Black permanent pen for eye detail
- Open toe embroidery foot (Bernina #20) and all purpose foot (Bernina #1 or #34) and BSR or free motion foot

Pre Class Preparation:

- Place pattern on light box or window and trace onto the back side of the pattern paper. We must mirror image the pattern when using fusible web or the pattern will be opposite the pattern picture.
- If you are familiar with using fusible web, you may organize pieces and trace the pattern pieces onto the fusible web

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.
