**Pattern:** Wild Blooms & Colorful Creatures by Wendy Williams

**Fabric:**

- 1½ yard solid red (Wendy used 1 yard of 55” wide linen, I used cotton)
- ½ yard blue dot (inner border) ( not needed in class)
- 1¼ yards red print (border) (not needed in class)
- ¼ yard red purple print (binding) (not needed in class)
- 3 yards backing (not needed in class)
- 52” X 66” batting (not needed in class)

**Wool Fabric: Must be a good quality felted wool, not wool felt and NOT craft felt**

- Six 10” squares of greens (or equivalent area)
- Twenty 10” squares of brights (example used 3 or 4 pinks, lavenders, yellow, blue, purples and oranges) These should show up on your background (red) fabric

**Supplies:**

- Freezer paper - six sheets, 8½ x 11” or equivalent on roll
- Pins
- Scissors - I like micro serrated, you’ll be cutting wool and freezer paper at the same time
- Fabric marker (please test removal on YOUR fabric) for red background.  
Optional for wool
- 24” or longer ruler
- Optional: circle templates or Perfect Circles (ranging from 9.25” to 3.25”)
- Optional: six ziploc baggies - quart size
- Optional: any (all) stitch dictionaries you already have
- Suggested: Roxanne’s Glue Baste It, or a glue stick such as Elmers washable or Uhu
- Optional: any tool that will cut circles out of wool (compass-like tools or AccuQuilt die cutter).

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**By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.**



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we’re all on different “thermostats”. You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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### Needles:

- #22 crewel needles (or whatever size you can thread your perle cotton thread into)
- #10 sharp - actually any long skinny sharp needle, to be used for hand basting
- #1 Milliner needle (or some similarly large size) if you want to do knotted stitches (bullion, cast-on...)

### Thread:

- Basting thread - your patching thread is fine, Bottom Line (or something slippery) is great
- Assorted colors of #5 and/or #8 perle cotton. Choose colors that show up on your wool flowers, include a few greens. Eleganza thread is a good choice and the variegated works well

### Bring to class:

- Supplies listed above

### Pre Class Preparation:

- On freezer paper trace or copy all of the applique shapes, pages 100-105 of book.
- Cut red (center panel) fabric to 34" x 47½"

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
