## Pickled Clams with Floating Edge Finish

with Karolyn “Nubin” Jensen

**Pattern:** Pickled Clams...Using Floating Edge Finish by Karolyn “Nubin” Jensen

**Fabric/Supplies needed:** This is a very scrappy happy quilt. There are 52 printed clams and 52 solid clams. All the Prickles on the clams are out of solid fabric.

I used 30+ different printed fabrics in my quilt. I pulled fat quarters that I loved and had fun! My motto on this one is “the more the merrier”. Each clam takes about a 6” x 8” piece of fabric. If you want it less scrappy...total yardage for printed fabric is about 2 yards.

- 14 different 1/3 yard cuts of solid fabric. This is to be used for the 52 solid clams and ALL the points in the paper pieced section. You can get 4 solid clams and enough points for 8 blocks from the 1/3 yard cut.
- 3 1/2 yards of a solid fabric for your background
- 1 1/2 yards fabric for binding on top of each clam (*I used the same fabric for the binding and piping*)
- 1 1/4 yards fabric for piping on each clam (*I used the same fabric for the binding and piping*)
- 1/2 yard fabric for inner border
- 2 yards fabric for outer border
- 3/4 yard fabric for binding
- 4 yards fabric for backing
- One sheet clear template plastic
- Piping Hot piping tool by Susan K. Cleveland
- Thread to match your piping and clam shell background
- Thread for paper piecing
- 24” x 6” (or 6 1/2”) ruler for cutting strips
- Good fabric scissors and good paper scissors
- Tracing pen/chalk/pencil to trace the clam shells onto your fabric
- 1/4” presser foot (with guide very helpful) Bernina #57 foot
- Applique foot (Bernina #23 foot) or zipper foot
- Table top light
- One ball of #18 Chalkline twine from Ace Hardware

**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different “thermostats”. You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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## Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, manual, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler
