Pattern: Playful Pachyderm Pattern by Desert Bloom Quilting

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- > 8 fat quarters for elephants & outer border
- ≥ ²/₃ yard background fabric
- ≥ 3/8 yard inner border
- > 5" or larger square of fabric for eyes (I used black)
- ▶ ½ yard for binding
- > 1 yard Steam-a-Seam lite 2 (or other light weight, double sided fusible)
- One 24" x 10" or larger piece of medium weight tearaway stabilizer (or other stabilizer of your choice)
- Applique pressing sheet
- 90/14 Topstitch needle (or Jeans/Demin needle)
 Note: Superior Titanium coated Topstitch needles recommended)
- > Presser feet-Bernina #20, 20C or 20D foot (open toe applique foot for other machines)
- ➤ 28 wt. Aurifil thread for top stitching in desired colors (on a grey spool)
- Matching (or close) 50 wt. Aurifil for bobbin thread (on a orange spool)

 Tip: for a more pronounced look consider a contrasting thread for the stitching, for a more blended look get a thread that closely matches your fabric

Bring to class:

- Sewing Machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

- Trace applique designs from patterns onto Steam-a-Seam lite 2 and roughly cut out around traced lines leaving a little bit of extra

Using the cutting diagram in the pattern, cut out border squares and elephants, ears and eyes
