Fabric/Supplies needed:

- Soft Fabric shoes (I used Toms)
- Medium weight cut away stabilizer
- Hot glue gun
- 1/3 yard cotton fabric - medium to lightweight
- Paper clips or pins
- Muslin or waste fabric for mock up (optional but recommended)
- Freezer paper
- Embroidery design (only needed if you are going to embroider)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Embroidery module (only needed if going to embroider)
- Basic sewing kit to include: water soluble fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins, pincushion, seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- None

* The embroidery design on the sample will be provided in class for those who want to embroider. You can also use any other embroidery design that can be sized to fit.

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.
